Sumptuous Slices, Now Available to Go

Artisanal, Terrance Brennan's brasserie in Midtown, used to be the only place where you could sample its sumptuously creamy cheesecake, with a pecan-shortbread crumb crust and a pecan praline crunch topping, \$9.50 a pop at lunch or dinner. Now its popularity has prompted Mr. Brennan to start selling the cheesecake retail. The seven-inch cake is said to serve eight, but its richness means that at least 12 slices could be cut from the cake, perhaps at a Mother's Day brunch. It is \$45 at Artisanal's cheese counter, 2 Park Avenue (32nd Street), from artisanalcheese.com and (877) 797-1200.
